<p>Background</p> <p>Some certification applications contain ST:s with claims to PP:s. A good PP may simplify the work for all parties in an evaluation and will generally lead to more efficient evaluations. However, PP:s that do not comply with the CC, that contain inconsistencies or contradictions, or that are technically inadequate, are likely to increase the time and cost for evaluations/certifications.</p> <p>CSEC reserves the right to refuse certifications based on PP:s that have been found inappropriate.</p> <p>PP:s that have been decided not to be accepted as a basis for a CC certification in the Swedish scheme, will be listed in this document, and in each case, the reason why the PP is regarded inappropriate.</p> <p>List of PP:s CSEC no longer will accept (the PP doghouse)</p> <p>PP REFERENCE</p> <p>Certificate Issuing and Management Components Protection Profile, 2011-08-11, document version 1.5</p> <p>REASON WHY THE PP WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED</p> <p>The PP is not CC compliant, giving rise to numerous evaluation and certification problems.</p> <p>DECISION DATE</p> <p>2020-May-07</p>
