## **Background**

Some certification applications contain ST:s with claims to PP:s. A good PP may simplify the work for all parties in an evaluation and will generally lead to more efficient evaluations. However, PP:s that do not comply with the CC, that contain inconsistencies or contradictions, or that are technically inadequate, are likely to increase the time and cost for evaluations/certifications.

CSEC reserves the right to refuse certifications based on PP:s that have been found inappropriate.

PP:s that have been decided not to be accepted as a basis for a CC certification in the Swedish scheme, will be listed in this document, and in each case, the reason why the PP is regarded inappropriate.
